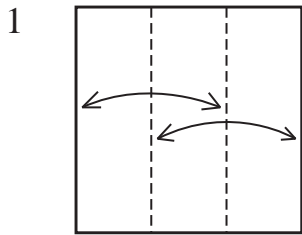
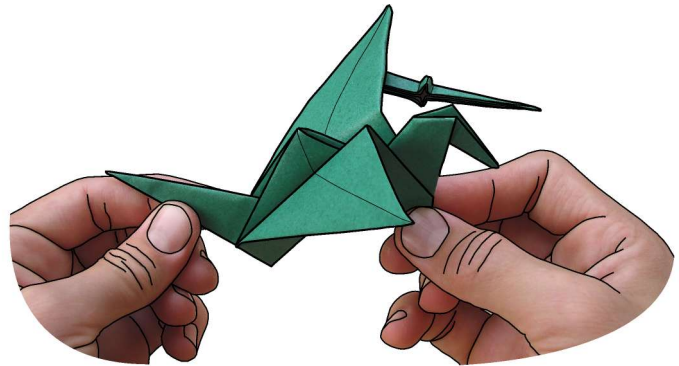


Warrior Crane

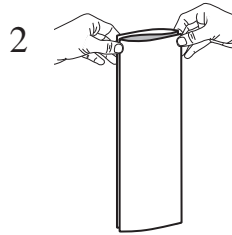

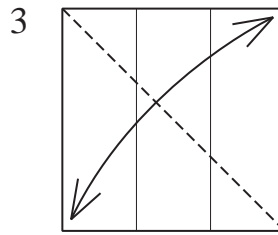
Watch out, this crane is not as peaceful as the traditional crane we all know so well.



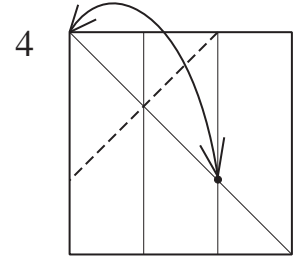
White side up, valley-fold and unfold in thirds.



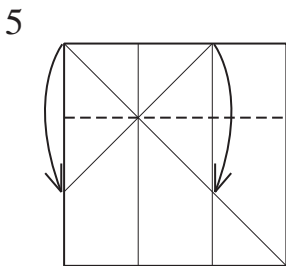
Here's one way to fold thirds. Holding as shown, fiddle with the folds until they line up.



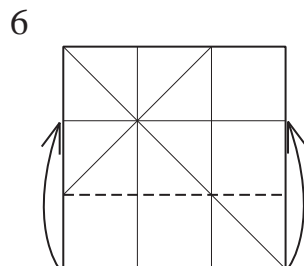
Valley-fold diagonally and unfold.



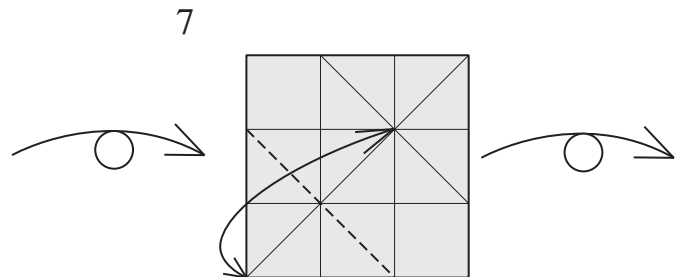
Valley-fold to the black dot.



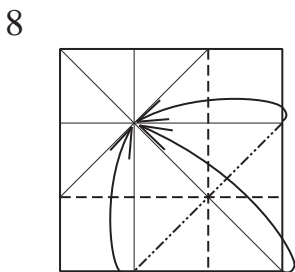
Valley-fold.



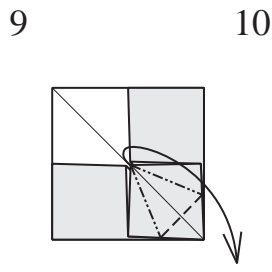
Valley-fold. Turn over.



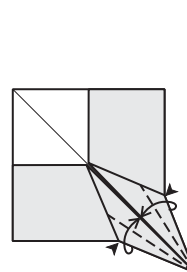
Valley-fold. Turn over.



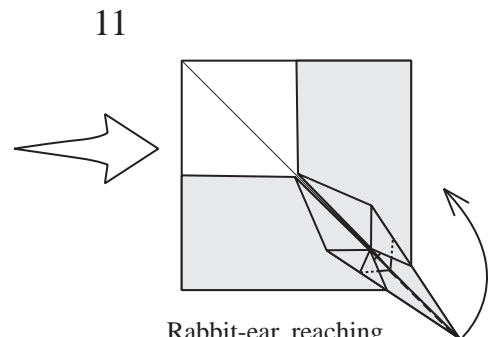
On the existing creases fold an of centered square base.



Petal-fold.

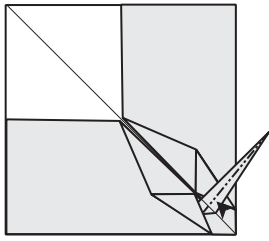

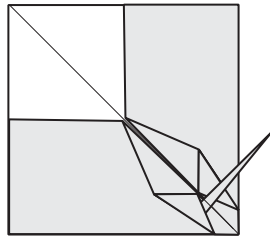
Rabbit-ear, reaching underneath the top layer.

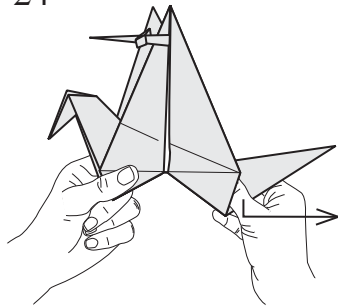
Holding as shown, push together, turning the appendage into a sword.

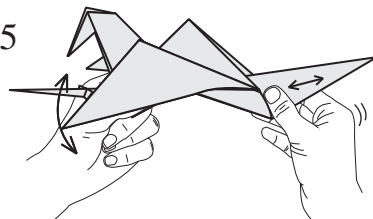

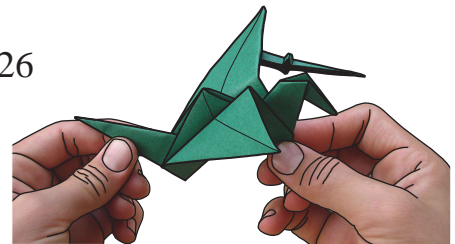
Hold firmly as shown. To make the wings flap, pull your right hand straight down and then to the right.
